

Overflowing with Divine Love.


This is the reward.



WHAT IS **DEVOTIONAL SONG?**

Sacred poems deal with the spiritual realm of human existence gvs. secular poems that deal with worldly concerns of the physical realm.





THREE MAIN COMPONENTS OF A DEVOTIONAL SONG 1) WORDS 2) MUSIC 3) BHAVA (FEELING)





1) WORDS of a song express some kind of communication with the Divine

'The most important aspect o devotion is

attaining love through LOVE.
This love should not be only associated with love towards worldly things, but it must be basically flowing towards a permanent entity that is God."

Words of devotional songs express a variety of devotional sentiments directed towards God:





Love for God **Praise of God Adoration for God Yearning for God** Songs of thanks and gratitude **Extolling aspects of** God which are dear to us.





THE PURPOSE OF THE WORDS: To focus our attention inward to our heart, the seat of the spiritual dimension of life.





GANESHA SHARANAM, SHARANAM GANESHA Lord Ganesha, I bow down to thee.

This is a prayer asking the Lord to protect us and remove obstacles.





2) MUSIC The part of a song that is the aspect of singing.





THE PURPOSE OF THE MUSIC: to amplify the power of the words and bring the words to life.





MELODY, the Bhajan tune, is comprised of PITCH (Raga: swaras) and RHYTHM (Tala: beats)





2.a.) PITCH: The relative highness and lowness of the notes (frequency, or number of vibrations)



RAGA:

The notes of a particular Bhajan are derived from one raga (scale).





GANESHA SHARANAM: Raga HAMSADHWANI: sa re2 ga2 pa ni2 sa sa ni2 pa ga2 re2 sa

To sing the swaras properly, it is necessary orient every pitch to "Sa."





Sing swaras with the drone. Good practice: hear the drone, generate the pitch of a swara in your head first, then sing it.





SWARAS (notes) of the song with equal rhythm:

NOTICE: The shape of the melody It mirrors something about Ganesh: The shape of the melodic line creates an image of bowing down. The first phrase also creates the shape of Ganesh's elephant trunk. The 2nd and 3rd phrase build in intensity by going successively to higher notes.

THE POWER OF DEVOTIONAL SINGING





"When all the participants in a bhajan (session) SING IN UNISON, what sacred vibrations are produced and what Divine energies are released! When these vibrations fill the world, what changes can they not bring about!"





WHAT RESPONSIBILITY THIS IS!





What does Swami mean by SINGING IN UNISON? Singing together as one voice. The key is knowing when to sing what notes. The WHEN is RHYTHM and the WHAT is PITCH





In group singing, the most important element is singing what we sing at exactly the same time. This gives power of intention.





The ABC of excellent group singing is Always Be Counting the RHYTHM.





This requires in inner counting. This inner counting brings life to the music.

COUNT and CLAP: 1234 1234 1234 1234

Always Be Counting





When everybody is counting (feeling the inner rhythmic pulse) everybody can sing with confidence and power.





Everyone can move forward like a Lion, rather than follow like sheep





The Drum is our focal point toward which we all must orient.



Always be listening to the drum to keep track of the beat of the music.





When we sing with confidence, the doors of our heart opens automatically and we really get into the singing.





Sing Ganesha again: count, clap, sing with confidence. BE TOGETHER!





3) BHAVA: THE EXPERIENCE OF SINGING WITH EMOTIONAL ENERGY



'Man is also essentially an embodiment of love. Man's love is becoming polluted because it is diverted towards worldly things. It is not possible to get the reflection of the beautiful divine Lord in a heart which is polluted."

"Bhajans must be a felt experience (not a mechanical experience). Do not sing with one eye on the effect the song makes on the listeners and the other, on the effect it makes on God. Let your heart PANT for God."





The Bhava is our feeling of sincerely praying to the Lord to protect us and remove obstacles that stand before us. We have to make a great effort to focus and direct our attention and energy on God, to focus and direct the prayer deep into our heart.



Singing with this intense feeling takes us within so that real devotion can happen:







PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER: PITCH, RHYTHM, **BHAVA**





Let's open the doors of our heart and enjoy the thrilling experience, which must leave us full of pure energy and elevated enthusiasm.





Using our awareness of the aspects of Pitch and Rhythm, let us sing together as a unified spiritual army of love.





Thus, while putting in the effort to sing with love, we have to also be sure put in the effort as a group to Always Be Careful (ABC) of Pitch and Rhythm.





Be aware of singing together in Unity with those around you.





Remember:
